

Dariel, JCSE promote CMMI model

DARIEL SOLUTIONS has partnered with the Joburg Centre for Software Engineering (JCSE) at Wits University to boost the development of the software industry by initiating the adoption of

the Capability Maturity Model Integration (CMMI) model. Developed by the Software Engineering Institute at Carnegie Mellon University in Pittsburgh in the US to help companies improve their ability to develop high-quality software and systems, CMMI is used to rate the maturity of an organisation's processes.

"CMMI is certainly one best practice model that is required locally, as maturity and this concept of repeatability and predictability is needed in the industry to ensure projects don't rely on software 'superheroes' to be successful but rather the entire project team," says Malcolm Rabson, MD of Dariel Solutions. "While CMMI is not a silver bullet, it certainly will provide the framework needed to implicate processes and people in a repeatable manner for successful software development."
